During the fiscal year ended September 30, 2009, the Company experienced significant adverse changes in its results of operations (in particular, revenue, gross margin, operating loss, and net loss) when compared to the prior fiscal year due primarily to adverse changes in the macroeconomic environment. During the fiscal year ended September 30, 2009, the Company incurred approximately \$60.8 million of non-cash expenses related to impairment of goodwill and long-lived assets in its Fiber Optics business segment, primarily related to the Company's acquisition of Intel Corporation's fiber optics assets in 2008. The Company expects to report a net loss of approximately \$136 million for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2009.
